Dr. David May gave his classification at the Jan. 17 meeting of the Waunakee Rotary Club.

David walked the assembled members through some of his background and his optometry practice with the aid of a Power Point presentation.

Graduating from Verona High School in 1987, David headed to the University of Wisconsin - Madison. There he obtained a bachelor's degree in zoology upon graduation in 1992.

Next up for David was optometry school. He headed off to Chicago to attend the Illinois College of Optometry, the closest such school. He said the school is one of only 17 optometry schools in the entire country.

David then worked with Davis Duehr Dean in Sauk Prairie from 1999-2006, before opening up his own private practice, May Vision, here in Waunakee in 2006.

An 11-year resident of Waunakee, David still resides here with his wife, Candace, and his young son.

David said many people think they have to go to a medical doctor for eye issues when, for many issues, they can go to an optometrist.

For example, David said, pre-and post-operative care can most of the time be done in his office for procedures such as cataract or LASIK surgery. In addition to those services, May Vision offers routine eye exams, diabetic eye exams, the diagnosis and management of numerous different conditions, and eyeglass and con-

tract lens fitting and repair, among other services.

He is also proud to participate in the InfantSee program, which provides free eye exams for any infant, with or without insurance, under the age of 12 months.

David said he has seen quite a few infants in town already and in the program's history, it has made some life-saving diagnoses.

David recommends routine eye exams at least every one to two years, but yearly for anyone over 50, contact lens wearers, those with changing prescriptions, diabetics, hypertensives and hypercholestermia.

He said when he opened May Vision, he wanted to do things right, so he purchased the best equipment he could possibly find. Yes, it cost more, David said, but it allows him to take the best care of his patients. Some of the technology he obtained included a camera that is able to take pictures of the eye for patients to be able to view.

In addition to his top-of-the-line equipment, David also offers the latest styles and fashions in eyeglasses, with over 600 frames to choose from. He carries no discontinued products and has a two-year warranty on frames and most lenses, including free adjustments and repairs.

Education is also important to David, so he uses the EyeMagination program to help him inform his patients about their eyes. Part of that education, he said, was stressing the importance of safety in the workplace and at home. Anytime you are

operating any time of power tool, you really should be protecting your eyes, David said.
