Waunakee Rotarians reviewed the many projects they have been working on at the July 1 club assembly.

Fellowship – Bill Tygum of the Fellowship committee noted that a second pontoon boat ride was added with a later time for those unable to be there for the 4 p.m. ride. Now a 5:30 p.m. option is available for the ride on Lake Wisconsin July 13.

Fundraising – Dave May said that committee is preparing for its biggest event – WaunaFest. So far, volunteer slots are filling up, but more help is needed on Saturday night.

Youth Exchange – Harriet Statz said Byrd had just returned from Chicago and would be traveling with Ellen Schaaf to northern Wisconsin. He will also take a trip to Grand Rapids. A farewell party is set for July 21 to send him back to Thailand, but the time and place have yet to be set. Also, a Youth Exchange Counselor and Youth Protection Officer are needed for that committee, Harriet said.

International Service – That committee came up with an idea for – and so is now in charge of – the WaunaFest float. Help will be needed, Linda Olson said. She mentioned that Bill Erickson is looking into another exchange where the district would host individuals from Russia.

Community Service – This committee is planning the senior citizen picnic for July 14. Connie Blau said a volunteer from Waunakee is needed to loan a gas grill. Also, Sean Wayne said the bridge project at the conservancy had been postponed until next year. But the

committee is looking into installing a pier at the Rotary Walk at Village Center Pond and is looking for proposals.

John Cullen said programs are scheduled through Sept. 30. Some notable ones coming up include a fraud fighter from AARP on July 8, WaunaFest president Larry Hooker July 15, the tour of the remodeled Fire Station Aug. 19 and a fellowship picnic at Village Park Sept. 9.

Membership – Roberta Baumann noted that the name of this committee's chair, Pat Durden, had disappeared from the roster, and that the roster suddenly named her the committee chair. Pat was absent and so could not solve this mystery. In any case, some ideas for recruiting new members included having brochures and membership forms available at the WaunaFest food tent, she said.

President Brent Ziegler filled the club in on some correspondence and discussion from the board meeting.

The club received thank you notes from Alex Kuehn, who received a scholarship, along with the folks at Occupaws and Haiti Outreach, Brent said.

Also, the board approved the addition of Alan Langetieg, a new member, and Larry Felsheim, a returning member, to the club.

And the club approved donating \$1,000 toward the Waunakee Community Band.
