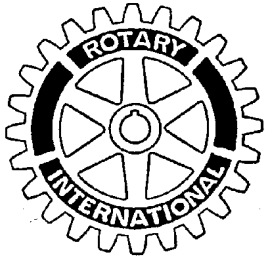

Waunakee Rotarians updated the club about committee projects at the June 2 meeting.

First, President Brent Ziegler inducted a new member, Bob Klostermann, who is a veterinarian. Welcome, Bob.

At the recent board of directors meeting, the club approved a \$500 grant to the Ghana water project, along with a \$250 donation to Wauna Golf, Brent said. Also, the club got the bill for the playground equipment at Village Park. The \$8,300 bill came in under the \$10,000 budget for the project, Brent said.

While the board voted to accept the memberships of two new members, it also accepted the resignations of James Brussell and Jeremiah Gollon.

Gordy Meffert gave some highlights of upcoming meeting programs. Next week, exchange student Hanoulia Salame will speak about her experience here. The club will meet at the new EMS building in July.

Harriet Statz for the Youth Exchange Committee said she has a report on all of the students' experiences this year. Hanoulia will give a speech at Waunakee High School commencement Saturday. She was the only youth exchange student in Waunakee this year, and her speech will be about being nice to strangers. Phil Willems for fundraising said Neil Krushek and Bob Ziegler are in charge of WaunaFest this year. If you don't want to sign up for a shift, pay \$50; Phil will hire a young person to work for \$25 and give the

remaining \$25 to Polio Plus.

Roberta Baumann for membership handed out small brochures about Rotary to members to distribute to folks they'd like to invite to join. Pat Durden talked about the iPhone Rotary app.

Shelley Moffatt said the international committee will pick up school supplies and will need help sorting them. She said the Ghana water project, with matching grants, will receive \$30,000, thanks in part to the \$500 donation from our club.

Sean Wayne said the community service committee is working on the pier at Village Park Pond. There is the potential for another bridge project and prairie upkeep work.
