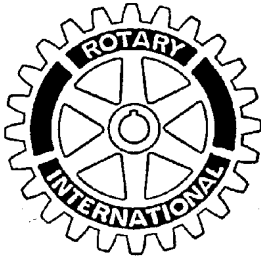

The Waunakee Rotary Club has several projects under way, and at the Sept. 1 meeting, committee members gave their reports.

•Linda Olson reported for the international committee. The club has an opportunity for an informal agreement to host a group of about 10-12 people from Brazil. They would visit our club for about three to four days. There would also be a possible opportunity for an exchange, with Waunakee Rotary Club members going to Brazil. In addition, Bill Erickson knows of another exchange with India in February or March. If you're interested in traveling to India, see him.

The committee is also working on the Guatemala well project, Linda said.

•Sean Wayne reported on the community service committee's work. There will be a project for club members to bring in garden plants or flowers to plant at the Village Center Pond.

The committee is also considering starting a community garden and has a couple locations in mind.

Also, when the village's Splash Park project gets under way in the next two to five years, Rotary would be interested in participating financially and in other ways, Sean said.

•Craig Larson provided the club with a list of teams for the Sept. 8 golf outing.

•Gordy Meffert said an interesting talk is scheduled for the Sept. 8 meeting. Alice Honeywell took a bicycle trip across the United States. And on Sept. 22, the club will have lunch at Endres

Manufacturing. It's the day before Wauktoberfest begins, so we'll eat under the big tent, Gordy said. The menu consists of German fare, and Ken Ballweg will discuss the history of Endres Manufacturing before leading a tour of the plant.

President John Cullen reminded the club that the District Governor is scheduled to speak at the Sept. 29 meeting and urged members to attend.

John also said the club's foundation board met to talk about the fund – which is doing fine, he said. The foundation board is comprised of five past president.

He also updated the club about the recent board of directors meeting. The board deposited \$577 from the Polio Plus jar, and combined with \$3,500 in donations from the Jim Schmitz and Jim Leonard families, the club has donated \$4,000 for a two-year period toward the Polio Plus effort. The board of directors also approved contributions of \$500 toward the American Red Cross; \$250 to Vogel Brothers for the purchase and distribution of school supplies; \$250 for Special Olympics; and up to \$2,000 for Rotary Lights for replacement bulbs and other equipment.
