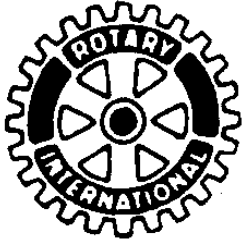

The Waunakee Rotary Club is donating \$750 to the Red Cross for disaster relief for the area of Southeast Asia that was hit by tsunamis Dec. 26.

President Phil Willems said he has received several contacts seeking donations, including some that would have been earmarked for buying boats and other specific items. The Rotary decided to donate to the Red Cross with no strings attached.

The need for aid to that area will be long-term, Phil noted.
