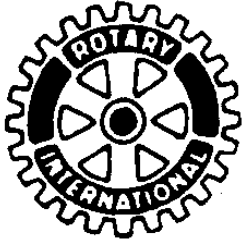

Rotarian Jeremiah Gollon gave his classification talk at the April 21 meeting of the Waunakee Rotary Club.

Jeremiah has been manager of the CUNA Credit Union's Waunakee branch for about a year. Before that, he worked at the credit union office in Madison and in Wisconsin Rapids.

CUNA Credit Union is the only credit union that has open membership – that is, anyone in the world can join, Jeremiah said.

A credit union doesn't pay income taxes because they don't have income, Jeremiah explained. Profits are returned to credit union members through favorable interest rates.

CUNA Credit Union tries to provide the best service possible and the best rates possible. A member survey showed a 99 percent satisfaction rate among CUNA Credit Union customers.

CUNA Credit Union is not affiliated with CUNA Mutual, Jeremiah said. The name similarity causes a fair amount of confusion, and a name change is possible in the not-too-distant future.

Jeremiah was born in Stevens Point and raised in Iola. He enjoys outdoor activi-
