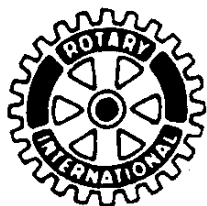

Providing quality of life at the end of life is the mission of HospiceCare, two representatives told Waunakee Rotarians at the Nov. 30 club meeting.

Laura Jennings explained that HospiceCare covers Rock and Dane counties, mostly offering services to people at home at the end of life.

Medicaid reimburses costs for staff, equipment and other expenses incurred, recognizing that it is more cost effective to have patients stay in their homes at the end of life, Laura said.

Hospice helps people of all ages and has a foundation to raise funds. Support from the community helps fund two beautiful buildings. Medicaid requires that 5 percent of the staff be volunteer, while 30 percent of HospiceCare's staff is volunteer.

Volunteers help in all areas, in the kitchens, the gardens, with administration and other areas.

About 400 staffers and 800 volunteers work with HospiceCare.

Basically, HospiceCare helps people with terminal illnesses fulfill their goals. The staff asks what patients want to accomplish in the time they have left. About 40 percent of the patients have cancer and want to live out the rest of their lives comfortably. Hospice staff are experts in pain management, Laura said.

Other patients have certain spiritual or emotional goals. One man with little time left wanted to see his son graduate high school although it was only March. HospiceCare arranged with school officials for an early graduation ceremony for his son at his home, so he could tell his son how proud he was of him.

Nicole Schultz works for the HospiceCare Foundation and informed the club of fund-raising events, such as the gala, the garden

party, the golf outing and the raffle. There is also a brick walk memorial program and memorials. A charitable gift annuity guarantees annuity payments for life at a fixed rate with a percentage eligible for a tax deduction.

HospiceCare started 28 years ago with only a nurse and social worker, Nicole said. Because of the community's generosity, no patient is ever turned away.

Other items:

- The senior citizen Thanksgiving breakfast was well attended, with about 110 breakfasting at the Senior Center this year.

- Tom Reis reported that the Rotary in Lights kickoff went well. The lights were turned on in the pouring rain, and no one was electrocuted. About 107 came a'caroling. The fund-raising is going well, Tom said, with \$35 collected at the gate the first night. Tuesday, \$120 was collected, and on Wednesday, the amount rose to \$160. To sign up or see when you've scheduled yourself to greet at the gate, check the Rotary Web site. There are about 30 percent more lights this year. Significant costs were incurred by increased electrical capability. There are now about five 200-amp services.
