



Waunakee Rotary Club

The Waunakee Rotary Club held club assembly at the Nov. 2 meeting. President Drew Lawrence reported on several projects and donations the board had voted on, including:

- \$1,250 for a well project in Haiti;
- \$250 for the Vogel Brothers donation of school supply project;
- \$200 for the Special Olympics;
- another \$250 for the Wisconsin Sports Development group, which is an active group for youth athletics.

•\$250 for the Waunakee Rural Aquatic Team, which is hosting a large meet in December at the Waunakee School District Aquatic Center.

The club plans to make a donation to Neighborhood Connection but has yet to determine the amount. Although Neighborhood Connection has found a space for an office and storefront, it is unfinished and will need electrical and plumbing. Along with a cash donation, labor will probably be needed, Drew said.

The various club committees also reported on their work, as follows:

•Jeremiah Gollon reported that the Fellowship Committee is planning the Christmas Party for Jan. 26 along with a Christmas in the Dells Broadway Show outing before Christmas. This would be a reasonably priced event that children would enjoy, too.

•Ray Statz reported on the International Committee. The Russians are coming again at the end of March, Ray said, and this will be a joint project with the Madison Horizon Club. Club members could help with transportation and entertaining the guests. Also, Lynn Spielman is currently in Nigeria working on literacy projects for women. Bill Erickson and Phil Willems plan to travel to Haiti for the well project, where they will also

help build a house. The sewing machine project is also well under way, Bill said. Women are enrolled in classes. Leonard Allen reported on a separate project. He and his family spent a weekend staying in a refrigerator box outside of his church to raise funds to extend electricity to a school in Peru. Although it rained and snowed, the box froze before it could deteriorate, Leonard said.

•Jim Tubbs reported for the Meetings and Public Relations committee. Speakers are scheduled for meetings through Dec. 21, and the club has received good publicity through the local paper, Jim said.

•For Membership, it was reported that three members had resigned from the club. Jason Brown and Carlyn Hensen both have changed job locations. Larry Felsheim is officially a nomad.

•For Community Service, Rodd Cupp said he had made several calls inquiring about a sign that might be placed on the edge of town informing folks of community events. Rich Murphy and Ed Niebuhr are chairing the Thanksgiving Breakfast. Volunteers will be needed for that, Rich said. Rotary in Lights is another project under way, Rod said, and sign-up sheets are going around. The committee is also planning another Superbowl event soon after the Christmas party.

•Greg reported that the Rotary Interact and Youth Exchange programs are making headway.

•For Fund Raising, Phil Willems reported that the fund raising for the Rotary in Lights is seeing more success. The club continues to raise funds because each year, capital improvements are made, such as the addition of a Santa house, a gingerbread house and a seven-swans-a-swimming display. Two youth sports
